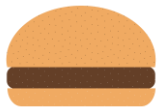

A reminder of the dates for the children's Christmas parties:

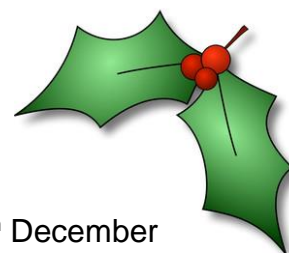
Year 5 and 6: Monday 18th December
