

SCHOOL MEDICINES PROCEDURES

As a reminder to our Parents, below are just a few points taken from our 'Supporting Pupils at School with Medical Conditions Policy'. The full policy can be found on our Website under 'School' and 'Policies'.

A parental consent form must be completed before the administration of any medication. These forms are kept in the entrance to the school or can be completed on-line and emailed to <u>Ihaworth@manorroad.lancs.sch.uk</u>.

- Medicines should always be provided in the original container and include instructions for administration.
- The school will not make changes to dosages on parental instruction.
- Once the medicine is no longer required in school or has expired, it is the parent's responsibility to collect the medicine and dispose of it safely.
- There is no legal duty that requires staff to administer medication. Unless a duty to administer medications is included in their job descriptions, the role would be considered voluntary.

All medication and consent forms should be handed to the school office staff by a parent/carer.
