Can we please remind all our families that anyone driving children to our school **MUST** not park in the school grounds after 8.30am or before 3.45pm, even if dropping off for Out of School Club, as we have children on the grounds at this time.

Exceptions are if you have a registered Blue Badge or a school car parking pass.

If you do have a Blue Badge or a school car park pass, you **MUST** adhere to the **5mph** speed limit along the slip road and on the school car parks.

Please can we also remind you all that there is a **20mph** speed limit on both Manor Road and Fiddler's Lane and you should ensure that you stick to this speed limit whatever time of day.
