

2024: Milly's Smiles

What do they do?

Provide a welcome bag, known as a Milly Bag, to families of children who have a new cancer diagnosis at Royal Manchester Children's Hospital, Alder Hey Children's Hospital, Leeds Children's Hospital and Nottingham University Hospital.

Milly Bags contain items that will help during the first few days, and weeks, of their hospital stay as well as items that will bring a smile to the faces of the children, and let families know that people are thinking about them.

How we can help:

From Monday 19th February and Friday 1st March there will be a box in the main entrance of school where we will be accepting donations of:

·Sealed packets of baby wipes

·Wash and go 2-in-1 shampoo

Regular sized bottles of shower gel

Packets of 2 toothbrushes
