School Policy

Digital technologies are an essential part of children's and young people's lives, both in school and outside. The Internet and other digital technologies are powerful tools and open up new opportunities for everyone. They can stimulate discussion, promote creativity and encourage learning.

These technologies are powerful tools, which open up new opportunities for everyone. These technologies can stimulate discussion, promote creativity and stimulate awareness of context to promote effective learning. Children should have an entitlement to safe internet access at all times.

The Acceptable Use Policy is intended to ensure:

- that children will be responsible users and stay safe while using the internet and other digital technologies for educational, personal and recreational use.
- that school systems and users are protected from accidental or deliberate misuse that could put the security of the systems at risk
- that children will have good access to digital technologies to enhance their learning and will, in return, agree to be responsible users.

Children's Acceptable Use Policy Agreement

Children will be asked to read, understand and sign the following agreement. Failure to sign and return this agreement will result in a loss of access to school systems and devices.

- *I will be aware of "stranger danger", when communicating online.*
- *I will only access websites using the recommended safe search engines or those directly approved by the teacher.*
- *If I see anything I am unhappy with, or I receive messages I do not like, I will tell a teacher immediately.*
- *I will use only my own login and password, which I will keep secret.*
- *I will take care of the computing equipment in school and understand that there will be a consequence if anything is deliberately damaged or broken.*
- *I will respect others' work, privacy and property online and will not access, copy, remove or change anyone's work without their permission.*
- *I will not take or share pictures/videos of anyone without their permission.*
- *I will be polite, kind and responsible whenever I am communicating with others online.*
