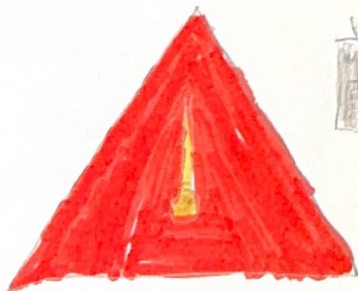

Please don't go on games over your age because there might not be something safe on there or you might cyber bullied.

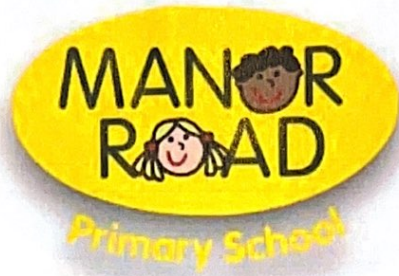
Make sure to not include your name in your password or even parts of your name. e.g. CAT gHT dog! *? ?

Tell. Always tell an adult if something worries you online.

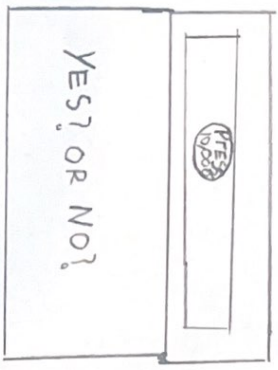
Always check the age rating on films - in case they have any inappropriate scenes!

Whenever in-game, make sure your guardian is ok with chat use!

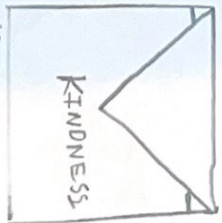


If you find a button or website tell an adult parent/teacher or guardian and people you trust because it could be a scam.



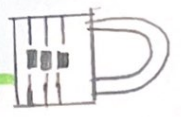
Are you a SMART ONLINE citizen

Staying safe online is really important you could give away passwords/emails/postcodes and personal information.



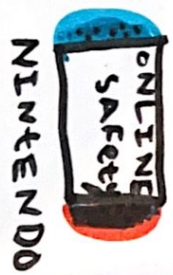
Help people by the stuff. Don't try to upset or worry people, use your manners.

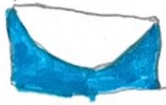

Making smart choices

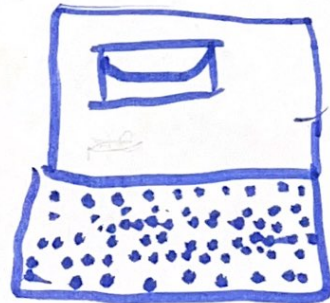
When some messages you, tell an adult so they can check if it's safe to open it.

If somebody or a stranger posts an embarrassing picture online just tell an adult and delete it fast.



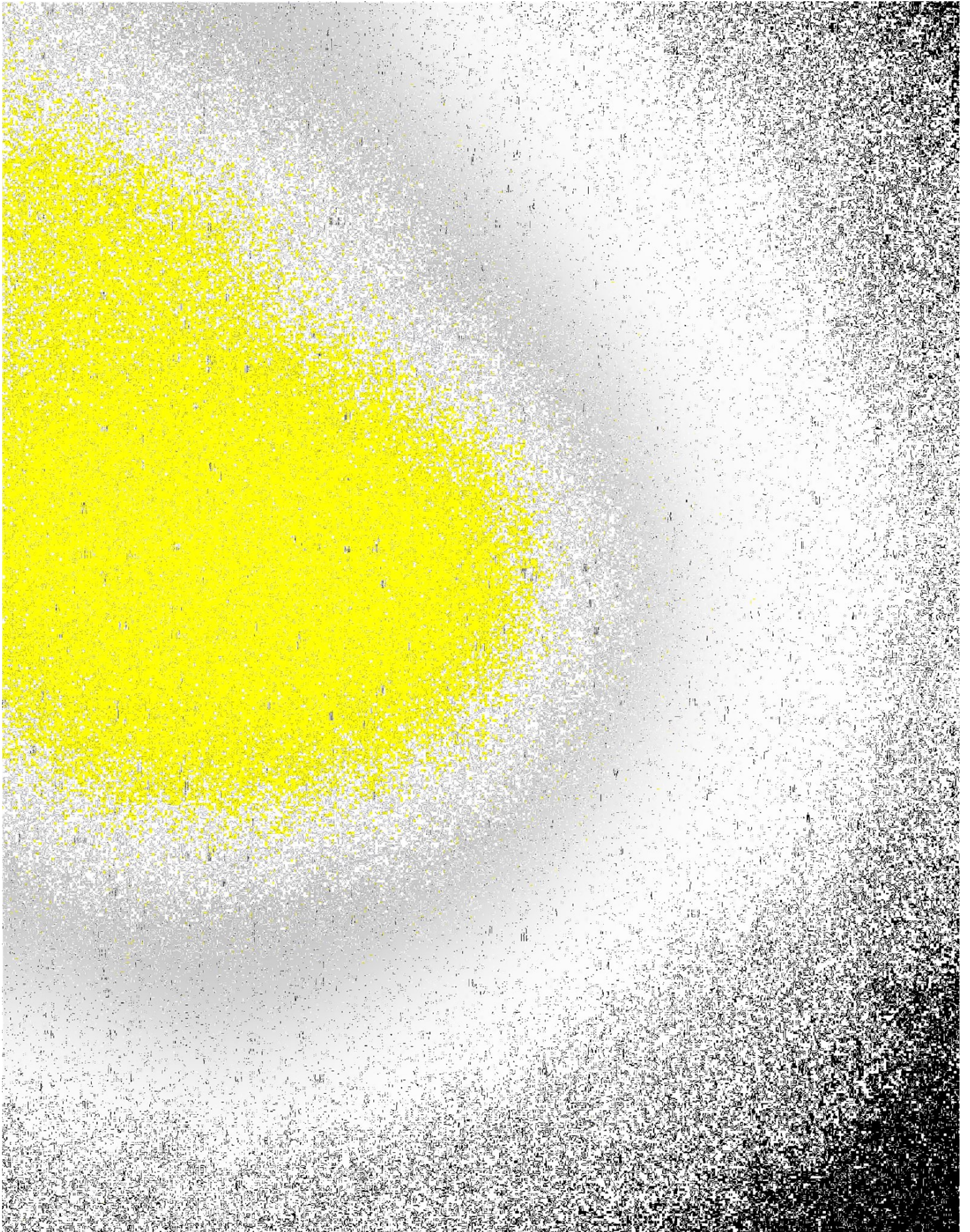

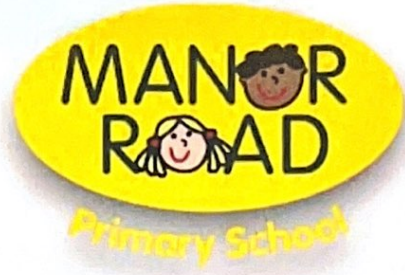

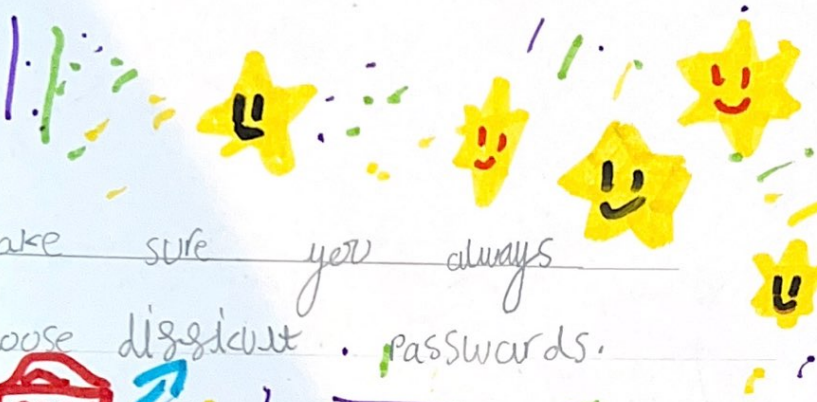

Never open any emails or messages from strangers. Ask an adult for help.

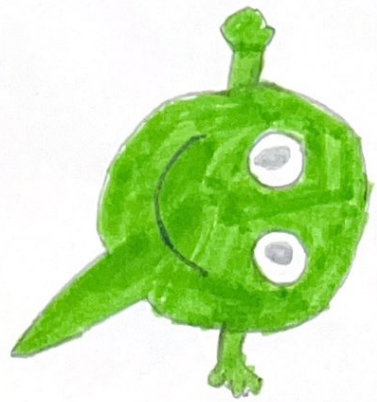

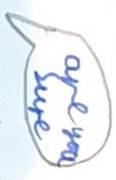
Safe

Reliable

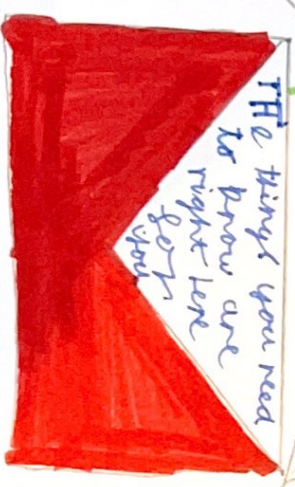


Check different websites or books to see if you think something is real on a website.
