CHRISTMAS COLOUR STALLS

We are delighted to be able to run our Christmas Colour Stalls again this year. This has always proved a really popular event, made possible by your generous donations, and highly enjoyed by the children.

For those of you who are unsure how it works details are given below:

- The point of the Christmas Colour Stalls is to give children the opportunity to buy Christmas presents for family members at affordable prices.
- Each class is allocated a colour – see below.
- Parents are asked to donate gifts in their child's class colour (these can be any gift item eg. toiletries, games, ornaments, chocolates, jewellery etc. – basically any small, affordable gift you might like to receive yourself!)
- We will be holding a non-uniform day on **FRIDAY 5th DECEMBER** when children are asked to bring their gifts into school. Children can wear their Christmas Jumpers on this day, or any suitable non-uniform clothes.
- On **FRIDAY 12TH DECEMBER**, during the morning, children will be invited to choose a gift to buy from any of the Colour Stalls. If sufficient gifts are received children will have the opportunity to purchase further gifts. Again children can wear their Christmas Jumpers on this day, or any suitable non-uniform clothes.
- Staff and volunteers wrap the gifts for the children ready to be opened as surprises on Christmas Day!

Year 5	Pink or Purple
Year 6	Silver
