## SAFETY AT MANOR ROAD

We have received a polite request from a local resident who is a wheelchair user and is struggling to access the pavements during school pick-up time. They have outlined some of the issues they have been facing which include:

- Cars parking in such a way that blocks a wheel chair user from using the pavement, forcing the user to travel unsafely down the road. This is especially dangerous when cars are parked on a corner as a wheel chair user is unable to see on-coming traffic from around the car.
- Parking over drop kerbs.

Parking in such a way causes problems not only for wheelchair users but for those with other mobility aids such as crutches/rollators and pushchairs.

We do understand that parking can be limited around the school but please can we ask that if you do need to travel by car, that you are mindful of those who require access to the pavements and help to prevent putting people in unsafe situations.
