SCHOOL SIGN IN/OUT SYSTEM

We would like to inform parents who are new to our school, and for those who may not be aware, that we now use an electronic sign in/out system. This is to be used by Parents/Carers to sign their children in or out of the building for those children who are:

- Late (arriving to school after 8.59am)
- Have an appointment to go to or are returning from an appointment
- Feeling too ill to remain in school



The touch screen is very simple to use and just takes a minute to complete.

All you need to do is:

1. Select the Pupils button
2. Select Sign in, Sign out or Returning
3. Select your child's school year
4. Select your child's registration class
5. Type in the name of your child and select
6. Complete your details
7. Add your signature
